## **Eternal Wall of Answered Prayer**

On a site near Birmingham in the heart of England, the Eternal Wall of Answered Prayer is a breath-taking new landmark that will celebrate stories of faith and answered prayer.

Due to open in 2027, it will stand over 50 meters tall and create a looping structure made from a million bricks, each representing an individual's answered prayer – a permanent reminder of hope, gratitude and the power of collective faith. It will be a once-in-a-generation national monument that will become as recognisable as the Angel of the North or the Millennium Dome. To record your answered prayers go to
