Inclusivity Studies

Beginning on April 30th, we will be offering a four-session course exploring how we understand same-sex relationships in light of the Bible. We are aware that this is a sensitive and important subject, and that within our church family there will be a range of views, questions, and personal experiences. Our heart in offering this course is not to pressure anyone toward a particular conclusion, but to create a gracious and respectful space where we can listen, learn, and reflect together.

As part of the course, we are pleased to welcome from the Baptist Luther King Theological College in Manchester, Jonathan Tallon, author of 'Affirmative', who will be leading two of the sessions. Alongside this, we will spend time looking at key biblical passages, considering different theological perspectives, and allowing space for honest questions and thoughtful discussion.

Each session will include opportunities to engage, ask questions, and share reflections, with the aim of growing not only in our understanding, but also in kindness, humility, and love for one another. We want this to be a space where everyone feels able to come as they are, to listen well, and to journey together with care.

Wherever you currently find yourself on this subject, you are warmly invited to join us for this four-week exploration.
